

Information for foreign students who want to study at CTU at the Faculty of Transportation Sciences

The date of the exam from English language (level B2) takes place on **June the 5th Wednesday at 9am in room B305** in the Faculty of Transportation Sciences building, Horská 3, Prague 2.

The international certificate holders of level B2 will not have to take the exams, their certificates will be accepted.

IMPORTANT: The exam is only open to students who have submitted an application to the Faculty of Transportation Sciences!!!

It is necessary to sign up for the English exam ahead of time by emailing Mgr. Jitka Heřmanová (hermaji3@fd.cvut.cz). The phone number is 608227145 The capacity for this date is 20 students. Please include your name and the date of the exam in the email and attach a copy of the payment.

The cost of the exam is 3000,- Czk. The fee must be transferred to the account before the beginning of the exam.

Bring your ID card and the original proof of payment with you to submit on the day of the exam!!!

An absence must be excused at least 2 days beforehand, otherwise the payment will expire.

The English exam requirements

The level of the exam B2 corresponds to the European referential "Common European Framework of Reference". The exam consists of both a written and oral part.

The written part of the exam (90 minutes long) includes reading,, grammar and vocabulary, and a short essay.

The oral part (15minutes long) verifies the applicant's oral skills via a conversation with the teacher about general topics of everyday life.

The results of the exam will be issued in the afternoon of the same day. Those who pass will be given a Certificate of English Exam Completion from CVUT Transportation Faculty.

A passing grade is 70 percent or higher in both parts. In case of failure in the written part, the applicant will not be able to proceed to the oral part.
