

EXTRAORDINARY TERM OF ENTRANCE PROCEDURE AND CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

INTO THE MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS AT THE CTU IN PRAGUE
FACULTY OF TRANSPORTATION SCIENCES
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025 - 2026

(WITH DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS 10th August 2025)

I. OVERVIEW OF STUDY PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH

The entrance procedure for applicants for the academic year 2025 - 2026 will take place in the following master's degree programmes.

Master's degree study programmes (following the Bachelor's degree programme)

The standard length of study: 2 years; degree: Ing.

* the IS program can also be studied in English in the form of a double degree in cooperation with a foreign university (Linköping University, Sweden)

** the SC program can only be studied in English in the form of a double degree in cooperation with a foreign university (The University of Texas at El Paso, USA)

The full-time study takes the form of daily classes. It consists of lectures and seminars in individual study courses. The study is project-oriented, which means that students choose their student project.

The Smart Cities (SC) study program, which is implemented as a double-degree program, has a fee of CZK 500 for each commenced semester of study.

The Intelligent Transport Systems IS (EN) study program, which is in the form of a double-degree program, has two fees: EUR 500 and CZK 500 for each commenced semester.

The tuition fee for studies in the English language (does not apply of double-degree program) is stipulated by the CTU Statute in Appendix No. 5, as follows:

- CZK 66,000 per semester for studies in a Master's program.

The course and conditions of study, including payment details, are specified in the study agreement between the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Transportation Sciences, and the student.

III. PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

The submission of a filled application form is necessary for the beginning of the entrance procedure. The number of applications for different programs is not limited. However, only one application can be submitted for the same program. If multiple applications are submitted for the same program, the application submitted later in time will be excluded from the admission procedure, and the application fee will not be refunded.

Applicants from Russia and Belarus are advised that CTU FTS is obliged to comply with the currently valid sanctions regulations of the European Union, the result of the admission procedure will be based on these currently valid sanctions regulations.

1) Filling out the electronic application form (will be possible from 1st May 2025)

Applicants have to fill out the electronic application form:

- on-line on the website www.prihlaska.cvut.cz
- completely and honestly
- in English

Applicants have to specify in the application form:

- type of study programme (master)
- form of study (full-time)
- programme of study (IS, SC)

2) Payment of the administration fee

There is an administrative fee of **950 CZK** for the tasks connected with entrance procedures (for each application form).

The fee must be paid by the deadline for submission of applications - **10th August 2025**.

Payment can be made by internet card payment at the internet address www.prihlaska.cvut.cz (we prefer this payment method).

It is also possible to pay the fee by cashless transfer by bank transfer or by postal order according to the information below.

3) Acceptance of the application as the beginning of the entrance procedure

The completed and paid application will be accepted into the entrance procedure only after the payment has been paired with the submitted application. Applicants can check the status of the application in their electronic application form. Payments made and sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

The last day for filling out the application form and paying the administrative fee is 10th August 2025.

IV. ADMISSION CONDITIONS

In accordance with the written instructions from the Faculty (delivered by email in August 2025), all applicants will submit documents listed below no later than the day of the entrance examination (or term set in the sent information).

1) Proof of previous educational attainment

All applicants shall submit an officially certified copy of their previous successfully completed studies according to the type of study programme.

The condition of a master's degree study program is the completion of a university degree of at least bachelor type. All applicants shall submit a certified copy of the Diploma and the Diploma Supplement or other confirmation containing a list of completed subjects and achieved study average. These documents do not have to be submitted by applicants who have completed a bachelor's degree program at the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Transportation Sciences.

The applicants who completed previous studies abroad will submit a validated Bachelor's Diploma – called **nostrification** (except for those who have completed their education in the Slovak Republic).

2) Proof of knowledge of the English language

(for all studies taught in English)

Applicants for study in the study programmes IS and SC are required to prove their knowledge of English. The level of English can be demonstrated in one of the following ways:

- citizenship of the state with the official language "English"
- confirmation of successful completion of previous studies in English
- confirmation of successful completion of English language course in the previous university studies (which as a whole does not have to be in English)
- internationally recognized certificate

V. ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS AND CRITERIA OF THEIR EVALUATION

The applicants will be accepted to the study after fulfilling all the previously mentioned conditions and on the basis of evaluation criteria set for each study programme.

The acceptance criterion is the number of achieved points. The final number of points of each applicant is based on the result of the entrance examination. The ranking of candidates is created by the number of points.

The minimum number of points required for admission to the study is set for each study programme.

The entrance examination will take place during one day in the period from 25th August 2025 to 12th September 2025. Date, time and place of the entrance examination will be stated in the invitation to the entrance examination that will be delivered electronically to the applicants by means of an email sent by the Faculty.

1) Intelligent Transport Systems (IS)

Applicants for the studies are to take a written entrance examination in two thematic areas. At the same time applicants participate in the project selection process.

Without a written entrance examination will be admitted to study students or graduates of the B1041A040001/B 3710- Technology in Transportation and Telecommunications study program at any university in the Czech Republic who have achieved an arithmetic study average of **1.0000** to **1.9000** (on 16th April 2025).

Without a written entrance examination will be admitted to the study applicants who have successfully completed a bachelor's degree study in English at a university in the Czech Republic or a foreign university. The previous studies have to meet the required applicant profile corresponds to the fundamentals of mathematics, physics, and technical disciplines (which corresponds to orientation in the direction of traffic systems and telematics, informatics and telecommunications).

Applicants for studies in the IS program taught in English, who have completed their previous studies abroad, must provide by **August 10, 2025**, a copy of the diploma from the university where they completed their previous bachelor's studies, a nostrification, as well as a transcript of the grades of all completed subjects, confirmed by the university, and knowledge of the English language.

The maximum number of applicants admitted to the study program is limited by the capacity of student projects.

Evaluation of written entrance examination

In the written examination of two thematic areas, the applicant demonstrates sufficient professional knowledge of the issues related to the program.

- a written entrance examination in each thematic area takes 45 minutes
- maximum total score is 50 points
- the minimum number of points required to be accepted to the study for the academic year 2025 – 2026 is set at **28**
- the maximum number of points from one topic is 25 points
- written examination is in the English language
- for the written examination, the candidate will only bring pen and several clean A4 papers
- It is not allowed to use any other aids or electronic devices, including mobile phones
- Topics are listed in the following table

Specifics of double degree study in IS

For studies in the IS (EN) program with instruction in English, applicants who have successfully completed their Bachelor's studies will be admitted without a written examination if they graduated from:

- a university in the Czech Republic with instruction in English
- a foreign university with instruction in English

provided that their previous studies meet the required applicant profile, which corresponds to a foundation in mathematics, physics, and technical disciplines (aligning with a focus in the areas of transport systems and telematics, informatics, and telecommunications).

These applicants must submit the following documents by August 10, 2025: a copy of their university diploma from their previous Bachelor's studies, nostrification (recognition of foreign education), a transcript of records of all completed courses certified by the university, and proof of English language proficiency through one of the following:

- citizenship of a country with "English" as an official language
- proof of successful completion of English language studies as part of their previous university education (which does not necessarily have to be entirely in English)
- an internationally recognized certificate

Applicants can apply for the assessment of their foreign education (so-called nostrification) through the CTU Rector's office: www.cvut.cz/uznavani-studia-ze-zahranici.

The IS program (taught in English) can be studied in double degree form in cooperation with Linköping University in Sweden, which implements the content-related study program.

Graduates of the degree program in cooperation with a foreign university are awarded the academic degree "engineer" (Ing.) And also the academic title of the foreign university according to the legislation in force in the respective country.

The Intelligent Transport Systems IS (EN) study program, which is in the form of a double-degree program, has two fees: 500 EUR and 500 CZK for each commenced semester. The details of the fee payment and the conditions of study will be specified in the agreement between the Czech Technical University in Prague, Faculty of Transportation Sciences, and the student.

Applicants must apply by submitting a letter, which they will upload to the application system: www.prihlaska.cvut.cz by August 10, 2025.

The cooperating foreign university reserves the right not to accept a double degree applicant. The Faculty of Transportation Sciences assumes no responsibility for this decision of the cooperating CTU in Prague.

2) Smart Cities (SC)

The Smart Cities programme can only be studied in English in the form of a double degree in cooperation with the University of Texas in El Paso.

Applicants for the study program do not take a written entrance examination. By August 10, 2025, applicants will upload the following to the application system: www.prihlaska.cvut.cz: a **structured CV in English**, one A4 page in length, and a **motivation letter in English**, one A4 page in length, demonstrating their interest in Smart Cities issues, their expectations from the study program, and outlining the topic(s) they would like to address in their diploma thesis.

This motivation letter will serve as the basis for discussion during an oral interview, also conducted in English.

- The maximum achievable score is 100 points.
- The minimum score required for admission is **70** points.
- For the academic year 2025–2026, applicants will be admitted based on their ranking according to the final score (FS) from the highest to the lowest, up to the number of admitted applicants.
- For the academic year 2025–2026, **a maximum of 5 applicants will be admitted**.
- The applicants' level of English language proficiency will be assessed by the committee during the admission interview.
- The second year of studies in the SC program is conducted in person in the USA. Therefore, due to the necessity of obtaining a US F-1 student visa, applicants must be citizens of a European Union member state.

The results are recalculated to a 0 to 100 points scale according to the following formula:

$$VPB = 40 \cdot \frac{1}{AP} + e + n$$

Legend to the formula:

- *VPB*.....total score
- *AP*.....arithmetic average in the previous bachelor's study
- *e*.....motivation letter in English (0 to 20 points)
- *n*.....evaluation of the entrance interview (0 to 40 points)

The Smart Cities (SC) study program, which is implemented as a double-degree program, has a fee of CZK 500 for each commenced semester of study.

Study in the SC program is intended for graduates of bachelor's study programmes with a technical focus; at the CTU in Prague, the Faculty of Transportation Sciences, these are all programs or fields with the exception of the PIL and TUL programmes.

Other prerequisites for successful studies in the Smart Cities program that the applicant acknowledges upon passing the entrance interview:

- requirement to pass TOEFL test during the first year of studies (min. 80 points for the internet-based test)
- requirement to try to pass the GRE General Test during the first year of studies (minimum score not specified)
- requirement to complete all courses of the Smart Cities program study plan during the first year of studies at CTU while keeping in mind that a grade worse than C according to the ECTS classification scale cannot be transferred to The University of Texas at El Paso

VI. RESULTS OF THE ENTRANCE PROCEDURE

The results of the entrance procedure will be published by 15th September 2025. Applicants can find the results in the application www.prihlaska.cvut.cz after entering their application code.

The Dean's decision of acceptance/non-acceptance will be delivered to applicants via email (within 30 days from the verification of all conditions). The decision also includes a statement of reasons and guidance on the possibility of appeal against the decision within 15 days of its notification. The applicant has the right to access the file only after the decision has been notified.

Notification of admission to study gives applicants the right to enroll in studies. The faculty shall communicate the date of enrollment to the admitted applicants together with the decision on admission to study. The applicant becomes a student on the day of enrollment.
